Teacher Library Cards & Privileges

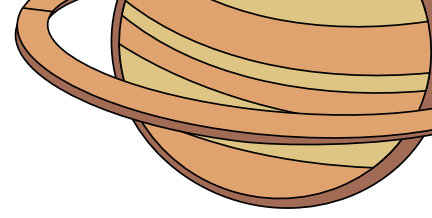
Massillon Public Library Teacher Cards are used to check out materials for the classroom or homeschool use and must be renewed annually. You may obtain one by visiting any location with your photo ID and school ID.

With the cards:

- Massillon Public Library materials are checked out for six weeks with one renewal
- Interlibrary loan materials are checked out for three weeks



Educators are responsible for lost or damaged items, but may be excused for certain circumstances. Please call the library should the situation arise.



Teacher Lists

Library staff can gather requested materials for use in a classroom or homeschool setting.

Please allow a minimum of two weeks' notice, as we may need to request materials from other libraries.

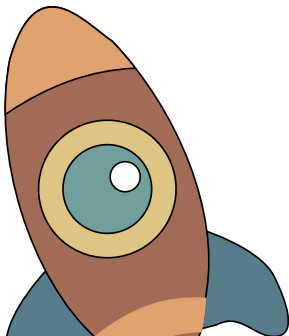
A pickup date will be determined at time of request.

Books-in-a-Box Collections

Books-in-a-Box (BIAB) kits are available for checkout to teachers, reading specialists, homeschool teachers, administrators, and others who need multiple copies of the same book! Each book is numbered for easy tracking.

We also provide individual preview copies of titles, separate from the BIAB kit.

These kits can be checked out for six weeks. Checkout extensions may be granted if there are no holds on the kits by another patron.

Please call the library before your due date to inquire about an extension. Educators are responsible for lost or damaged items.

Children up to the age of 5 are invited to a fun program of singing, dancing, and listening to stories together.

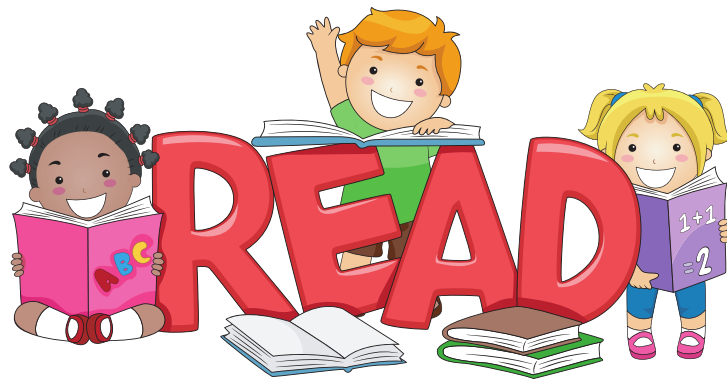
