Teacher Library Cards & Privileges


Massillon Public Library Teacher Cards are used to check out materials for the classroom or homeschool use and must be renewed annually. You may obtain one by visiting any location with your photo ID and school ID.

With the cards:

- -Massillon Public Library materials are checked out for six weeks with one renewal
- -Interlibrary loan materials are checked out for three weeks



Educators are responsible for lost or damaged items, but may be excused for certain circumstances. Please call the library should the situation arise.

Please allow a minimum of two weeks' notice, as we may need to request materials from other libraries.


A pickup date will be determined at time of request.


Books-in-a-Box Collections
